I. Preliminary Information:

No purchase necessary. Open only to legal residents of New York, New Jersey or Connecticut. Void where prohibited.

II. Step-by-Step Instructions

1. TO ENTER:

Complete the application form, which includes name, mailing address, phone number, email address, and overview of the environmental project. Representatives from RNN and Entergy will determine the top 4 entries.

The top 4 entries will be featured on RNN's I on the Environment segment during April and May 2008. The grand prize winner will be determined by viewers voting for the best project on rnntv.com.

The grand prize winner will receive a \$5,000 grant towards their project.

Alternatively, you may enter by mailing your name, address, phone number, e-mail address (if any), and written overview of the environmental project to: **RNN / I on the Environment Contest c/o RNN, 800 Westchester Avenue, Suite S-640, Rye Brook, NY 10573.**

Entries generated by a script, macro or other automated means will be disqualified.

Entries that are incomplete, illegible or corrupted are void and will not be accepted.

The 4 winners will be featured on RNN's weekly segment I on the Environment.

The grand prize winner will be determined by voting among the top 4 projects on rnn.com. The project with the most votes wins. The grand prize winner will receive a \$5,000 grant towards their project.

Prizes won by minors will be awarded in the name of their parent or legal guardian.
